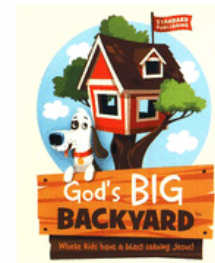
### Vestry Meeting – July 2

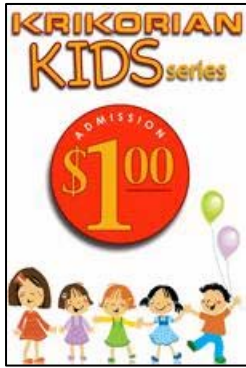
